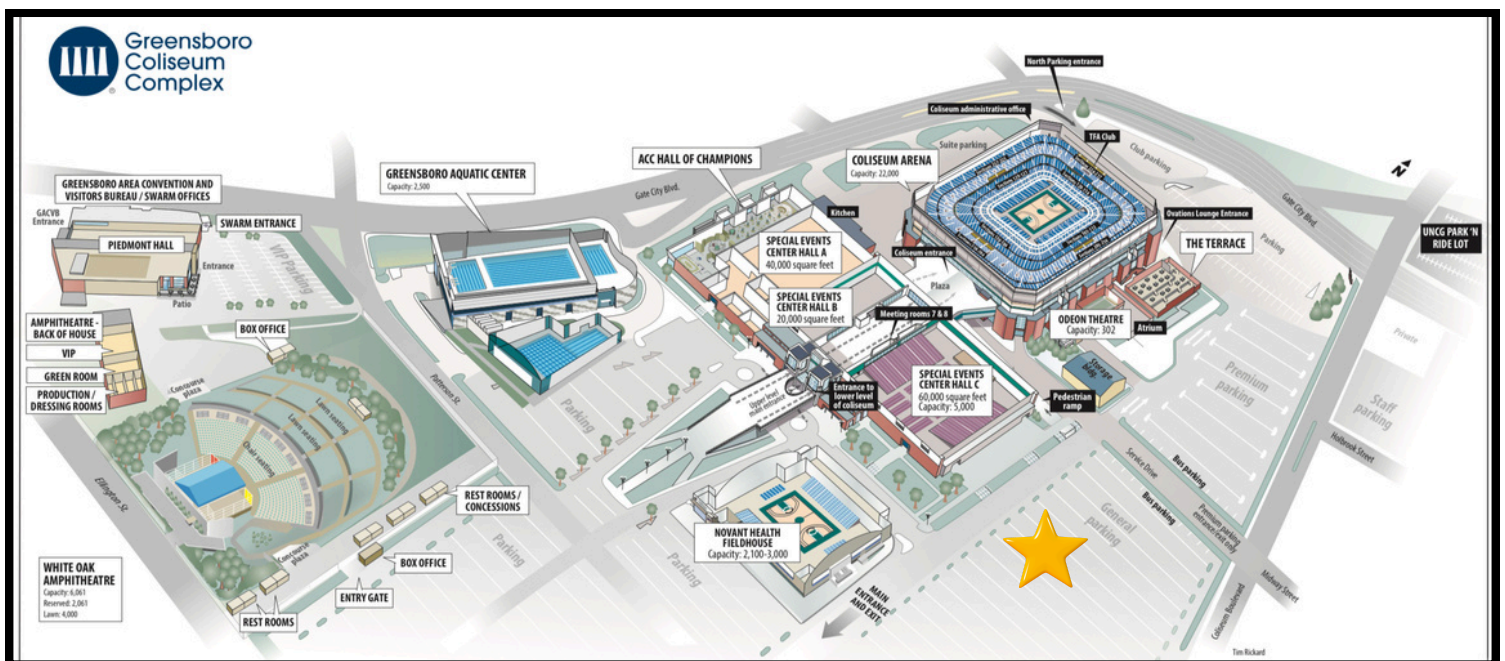

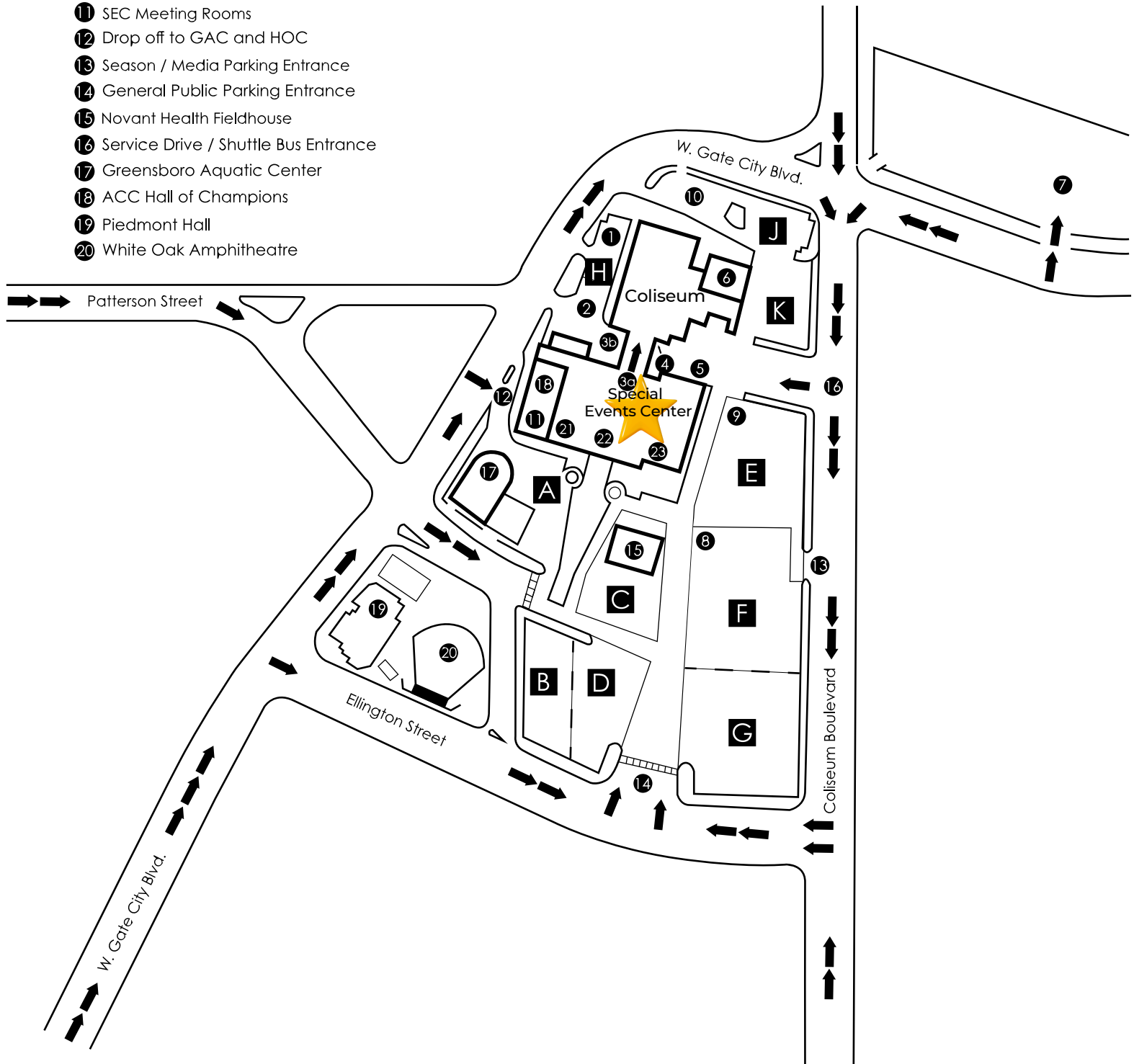

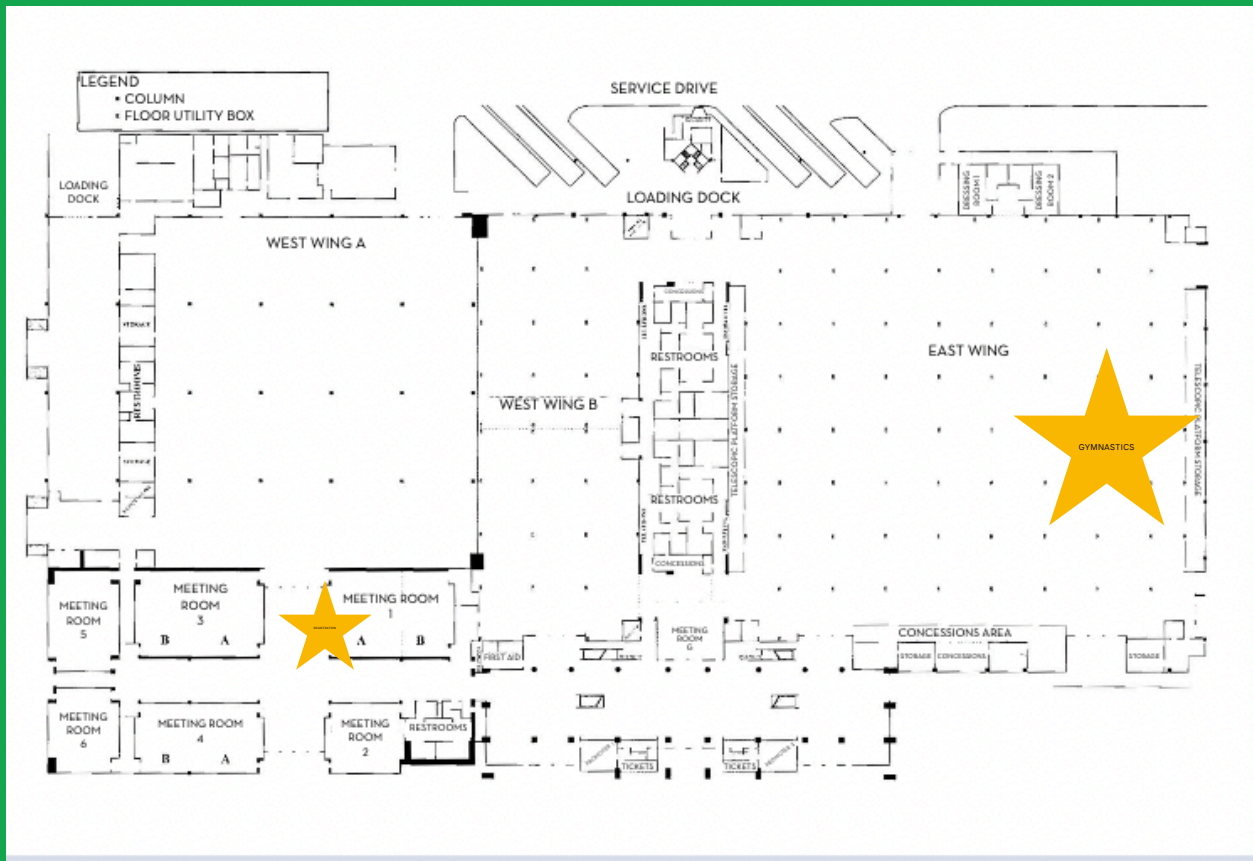

# Registration

Coaches & athletes pick up their credentials and gifts in the Registration room located in **Meeting Room 1** inside the lower level of the Special Event Hall.



Coaches & athletes are encouraged to check in Friday evening or anytime before their designated session (located in the concourse of the special events center). Coaches & athletes must wear these credentials to gain entrance into the competition venue. Gymnasts wishing to return to another time to cheer on their teammates will need these credentials to gain free entrance.

\*Note registration on Friday is posted to end at 4pm but gymnastics has requested it stay open until at least 6pm. However, we cannot guarantee late registration availability

**Level 1-7, Copper, Bronze, Silver, Gold, Platinum:** The top 6 gymnasts in each event (Vault, Bars, Beam or Floor) at each level ACROSS age groups (plus a possibility of one “Premier Pick” gymnast) will be invited to compete in the Event Finals on Sunday.

**Open Division:** The top 6 gymnasts in each event (Vault, Bars, Beam, or Floor) WITHIN each designated age group: 11 & under, 12-13 year olds, 14-15 year olds, 16-18 year olds will be invited to compete in the Event Finals on Sunday.

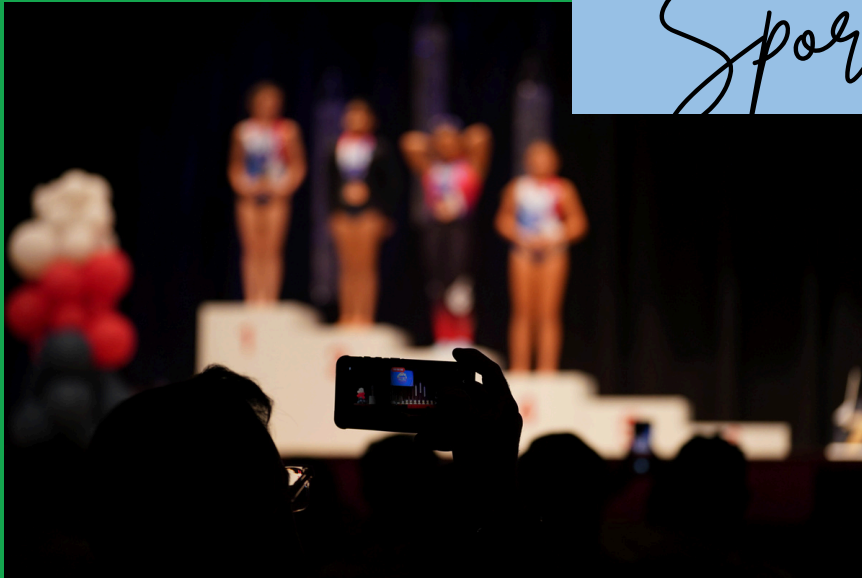
**Event Finals:** On Sunday, the gymnasts will compete ONLY the events in which they qualified for on Saturday, and there will be NO All-Around competition.

**Additional Notes:** If your gymnast attended AAU Nationals and placed on the National Team in levels 1-7, Copper, Bronze, Silver, Gold or Platinum, then your gymnast level will be the same as what they competed at AAU Nationals. If your gymnast was not selected as a National Team member in those levels OR did not attend AAU Nationals, then your gymnast is registered to compete in the Open Division, under the Junior Olympic Rules ([found here](#)) regardless of what level was selected in Meetmaker. \*Open Division follows ONE set of rules best fit for all optional level gymnasts across levels 6-10/Platinum-Sapphire.

# Reminders

- Please arrive 30 minutes prior to your scheduled session to allow time for parking, navigating the coliseum complex, ticketing and gymnast check-in.
- This is an AAU licensed event: only pre-registered AAU gymnasts, coaches, staff and judges are allowed onto the competition floor. If you need your athlete, please contact your coach.
- Please be mindful not to use excessive glitter or makeup that leaves residue on equipment.
- Do not allow your children to throw balls in the spectator area as this poses a risk to the competitors.
- Flash photography or lights on cameras is prohibited for the safety of the gymnasts.
- Weapons are strictly prohibited \*see coliseum website for more restricted items.
- Sideline coaching can be very distracting and dangerous to the gymnasts. Allow your coaches to do their jobs during the event. Sit back and enjoy watching your gymnast's hard work pay off this season!

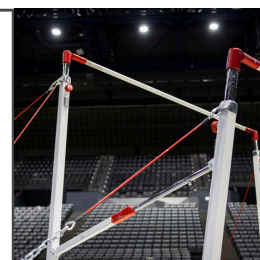
